WAGES COUNCILS**Aerated Waters Wages Council (Northern Ireland) (Abolition) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1978***Made* 2nd May 1978*Coming into operation* 5th May 1978

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a) and now vested in it(b), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Aerated Waters Wages Council (Northern Ireland) (Abolition) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 5th May 1978.

Abolition of Wages Council

2. The Aerated Waters Wages Council (Northern Ireland) is hereby abolished.

Revocation

3. The Aerated Waters Wages Council (Northern Ireland) (Constitution) Order 1950(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order abolishes the Aerated Waters Wages Council (Northern Ireland) which was established in 1922 as a Trade Board under the Trade Boards Act 1909. The Trade Board was converted into a Wages Council by the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945.

The Wages Council operated in relation to workers employed in the aerated waters trade in Northern Ireland.
