## The Legal Aid (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1982

*Made - - 17th December* 1982

Laid before Parliament 10th January 1982

Coming into Operation 1st February 1983

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 9(6) and 20 of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1983.
- 2. In regulation 96 of the Legal Aid (General) Regulations 1980(b), for paragraph (a) there shall be substituted—

"(a) any interim payment made in accordance with an order made under Order 29, rule 11 or 12 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, or Order 13, rule 12 of the County Court Rules, or in accordance with an agreement having the same effect as such an order:".
