The Borough of Merthyr Tydfil (Electoral Arrangements)  
Order 1986

Coming into Operation

Whereas in pursuance of a resolution of 28th August 1986 the Council of the Borough of Merthyr Tydfil have, under section 26(2)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), requested me to provide for a system of whole council elections to the Council:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by sections 26(4) and 67 of that Act, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Merthyr Tydfil (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1986 and shall come into operation one month after the day on which it is made.

2.—(1) The ordinary elections of councillors for all the wards of the Borough of Merthyr Tydfil shall take place simultaneously in 1987 and every fourth year thereafter.

(2) All the councillors of that Borough shall retire together in 1987 on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election and the newly elected councillors shall come into office on the day on which their predecessors retire.
